



Canadian Breeders Arabian & Partbred Arabian Futurity

The 2010 Canadian Arabian & Partbred Arabian Yearling & 2 Year Old Futurities will be held at the Eastern & Western Canadian Breeders Championships and at the Atlantic Canada Arabian Horse Show. Foals that are entered into the program and participate in their respective Futurity Halter Class are eligible to receive prize money.

Eligibility:

- Canadian-bred Arabian or Partbred Arabian (as recorded on the Certificate of Registration)
- Fully registered with the CAHR or CPAR by April 1st of Yearling Year
- Owner must be current members in good standing with the CAHR
- Nomination forms & complete payment of all fees must be received at the CAHR by specified deadline
- Entries may be cancelled by the CAHR if any requirement is not met. Fees will not be refunded.
- It is the responsibility of the owner of the foal to ensure all entry requirements are met

Fees: Note -Entries must be submitted to the CAHR by the closing date for show entries as advertised in each respective host show's prizelist. Classes with less than three entries at the end of close may be cancelled. Fees for cancelled classes will be refunded.

Total Yearling Fees - \$125.00 broken into payment schedule as follows:

**Fees must be postmarked by specified deadlines to maintain eligibility in the futurity. Late payments for the Yearling and/or 2 Year Old classes may be accepted along with a \$75.00 late fee. Acceptance of late fees are subject to approval by the CAHR as classes with less than 2 entries at the close of show entries may be cancelled. Fees will be refunded in the case of low entries resulting in the cancellation of a class.

Memberships:

The owner of the foal must be a current member in good standing with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry (CAHR) to be eligible to participate in the Futurity and must have a membership for each year the foal will be actively maintained in the Futurity. Membership with the CAHR and with Equine Canada will be required to show in the Futurity Classes only.

Classes:

Classes will be held at a CAHR Approved show and will include the following divisions: Purebred Yearling Fillies, Purebred Yearling Colts & Geldings, Partbred Yearling Fillies, Partbred Yearling Colts & Geldings.

Payment of Futurity fees allow a foal to be eligible for prize money but does not automatically provide entry into a class. A separate Entry Form will be included with the host show prizelist and must be submitted by entry deadline. Handlers in the Futurity Classes must be a Canadian resident* and may be an amateur or professional. All rules of the Host Show must be followed. *To be considered a Canadian Resident and therefore eligible to show in the Futurity, individuals must have been living in Canada a minimum of 6 months prior to the show.

Awards:

Ribbons & Prize Money will be awarded to the Top Six placings in each class. Distribution of prize money from the accumulated pool will be as follows: First (Champion) - 35%, Second (Reserve) - 20%, Third - 15%, Fourth - 9%, Fifth - 6%, Sixth - 4%. The breeder of the Champion from each class will receive 4% and the breeder of the Reserve will receive 3%. The remaining 4% will be retained for Ribbons and misc. fees. In cases where there are less than a full Top 6 awarded, the prize money will be adjusted accordingly so that all of the money collected is paid out in the same year.
