### QUALIFYING ENTRIES

- The horse must be bred by a Canadian breeder.
- The horse must be registered by the CAHR.
- The horse must be entered in the Western Canadian Breeders Show.
- Qualifying horses will compete with the breeders' name as listed on the CAHR Certificate only.

### AWARDS

The Breeders Cup along with a "cash prize" of \$1,000 (one thousand dollars) will be presented to the winner at the close of the Western Canadian Breeders Show on Saturday evening.

### TIE-BREAKERS

- If there is a tie score, the money prize will be divided equally.
- In the event that there are three or more breeders with the same score, the breeder with the most horses bred and registered in the AHA records will win the money prize.

### HOW POINTS ARE AWARDED

- Any breeder may enter as many horses in the show in as many classes as he or she wants. However for points toward the Breeders Cup, only the breeders' top 3 horses will qualify.
- Points will be awarded to horses in all classes entered.
- Points will be awarded as follows:

Champion.....	10 points
Reserve Champion.....	7 points
Third Place.....	4 points
Fourth Place.....	3 points
Fifth Place.....	2 points
Sixth Place.....	1 point
- Points will be added up during the show on each breeder, and the breeder with the most points on his top scoring (one to three) horses will be recognized as the top breeder for that year.
